

THE RAJPUT-BHATI COMMUNITY'S LEGACY OF RAVANA EFFIGIES IN METROPOLITAN DUSSEHRA CELEBRATIONS -A JOURNEY OF SOCIO-ECONOMIC TRANSITION



In the heart of India's vibrant metropolitan cities, as the festival of Dussehra approaches, a unique and deeply rooted tradition unfolds — the creation and sale of Ravana effigies, a craft passed down through generations of the Rajput-Bhati community. Known for their warrior heritage and intricate craftsmanship, this community has long been synonymous with the creation of grand, towering effigies of the demon king Ravana, a central figure in the Dussehra celebrations. As millions of people across the country gather to witness the burning of Ravana's effigy, few realize the intricate stories behind these massive statues and the community that keeps this tradition alive, even in the rapidly modernizing urban landscapes.

A Tradition of Craftsmanship and Legacy

The Rajput-Bhati community, traditionally from the Rajasthan region, has long been celebrated for its warrior heritage and skilled craftsmanship. The Bhatis, who belong to a distinguished Rajput sub-clan, have a history steeped in both valor and artistry. While many of them are known for their roles as soldiers, rulers, and landowners, a significant number of Bhati families have also embraced the arts, especially the crafting of effigies for the grand Dussehra celebrations. This tradition dates back centuries and has become an integral part of their cultural identity.

For these artisans, making Ravana effigies is more than a business. It is a celebration of culture, history, and heritage. In cities of North India, where the festival of Dussehra is celebrated with grand processions and rituals, the Rajput-Bhati community has carved out a niche for themselves, creating towering, intricately designed Ravana effigies that stand as symbols of both artistic expression and cultural continuity.



From Rajasthan to the Metropolis, for many Rajput-Bhati families, the craft of creating Ravana effigies began in their native villages, where the tradition was passed down through generations. However, as urbanization accelerated in the second half of the 20th century, many of these families migrated to India's metropolitan cities in search of better opportunities.

In cities like Delhi, Mumbai, and Kolkata, the demand for large, handcrafted Ravana effigies grew as the scale of Dussehra celebrations became more elaborate. As the festival of Dussehra has become a focal point of celebration in cities across India, the Rajput-Bhati community's contribution goes beyond commerce; it is a living, breathing link to India's rich cultural past.

The Craft of Creation: More Than a Business

Creating a Ravana effigy is an art form that requires precision, patience, and immense skill. Bamboo, papier-mâché, cloth, and paint are the primary materials, but it is the craftsmanship that elevates these creations into something extraordinary. Each effigy is crafted with intricate details, from the ten heads of Ravana to the vibrant clothing and jewelry that adorns the figure. Many of these effigies are several stories high, towering over the crowds in the Dussehra processions, making them both a spectacle and a statement.

The community takes great pride in their work. Each effigy is a work of art, with hand-painted faces, elaborate ornaments, and an expression that evokes the malevolence of Ravana. It is an emotional and cultural endeavor, one that requires immense teamwork, dedication, and a deep understanding of the festival's significance. The craftsmen spend weeks, sometimes months, preparing for the event — often working long hours in the lead-up to Dussehra.

For the Rajput-Bhati community, selling these effigies is not just about the economic gain; it is about maintaining their connection to a tradition that has stood the test of time. The effigies are sold at a variety of price points depending on their size, quality, and intricacy, and each piece carries the pride of generations past. Some families have seen their Ravana effigies displayed in major cities, while others continue to serve local communities with smaller creations for village festivals.

Cultural Impact: Preserving Identity in a Modern World

In the fast-paced, globalized world of today's metropolitan cities, the Rajput-Bhati artisans' continued dedication to their craft is a testament to the community's resilience and commitment to cultural preservation. Despite facing challenges from mass-produced effigies, these artisans have managed to maintain their status as the premier creators of authentic, handcrafted Ravana effigies. Their work is not only a source of income, but also a way to preserve their ancestral traditions, which might otherwise be lost in the tide of modernity.

Their impact extends beyond the crafting and selling of effigies. By participating in the Dussehra celebrations, the Rajput-Bhati community remains visible and active in the urban cultural landscape, fostering awareness and appreciation of their heritage.
